为大力实施创新驱动战略，围绕建设高科技产业城，深入推进“530”计划，以更大力度吸引海内外高层次人才来锡创新创业，促进科技创新和产业转型升级，加快建设“东方硅谷”，为率先基本实现现代化提供科技和人才支撑，无锡驻英人才站将在牛津大学举办宣讲会。

无锡市曾被《财富》杂志评为“中国最佳商务城市”，连续多年入选福布斯大陆最佳商业城市。无锡市提出的“530计划”旨在引进领军型海外留学归国创业人才，大力度、广范围、宽领域地引进海外高层次人才。考虑到海归企业落户之初人生地不熟，无锡市政府还陆续推出了一系列诸如“创业导师”、“创业保姆”等政策以解决海归企业“水土不服”的问题，保护他们更好地成长。

同时，无锡政府出台了一系列政策，鼓励和吸引有贤之仕前往无锡发展。

一）对于国际国内顶尖人才：

给予引进的诺贝尔奖获得者原则上不少于2500万元科研成果产业化配套资金，并给予500万元安家补贴。

二）对于科技创业领军人才：

1) 视创业项目规模和投资力度，提供100万元-500万元科研成果产业化配套资金。

2) 提供不少于100平方米工作场所、100平方米住房公寓，三年免租金。

3) 在锡购房，提供100万元安家补贴，分5年支付。

4) 对科技创业领军人才的创业团队核心成员，自其交纳个人所得税起，连续三年个人所得税地方留存部分以奖励的形式返还。

三）对于科技创新领军人才：

1) 对符合条件的，视其承担项目的规模和进度，给予最高200万元科研成果产业化配套资金；在锡购房，给予70万元安家补贴，分5年支付。

2) 对符合条件的，视其承担项目的规模和进度，给予最高100万元科研成果产业化配套资金；在锡购房，给予50万元安家补贴，分5年支付。

3) 对符合条件的，在锡购房，给予30万元安家补贴，分5年支付。

4) 对“中华技能大奖”、“全国技术能手”获得者在我市领衔建立技能大师工作室、开展高技能人才培训的，给予2万元启动经费；对获评无锡市首席技师的，给予2万元奖励。

5) 对本市现有的国家级专家，给予每人每月500元补贴。

四）对于创新创业领军团队：

1) 对入选的“创新创业领军团队”，给予每个团队300万元-800万元的人才项目经费资助，分5年支付。
